Mr. Fuselier made a motion to approve the revised agreement with Wathen, DeShong & Juncker, LLP to include the performance of a Single Audit for federal funds received for the Fiscal Year ending September 30, 2019. Mr. Covington seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF SETTING THE DISTRICT'S ANNUAL EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTION RATE TO THE TEXAS COUNTY AND DISTRICT RETIREMENT SYSTEM (TCDRS) FOR PLAN YEAR 2020 AT 13.84% (13.50% FOR RETIREMENT PLAN RATE, AND 0.34% FOR GROUP TERM LIFE RATE), OR ALTERNATIVELY AT SUCH OTHER PERCENTAGE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Mr. Fuselier made a motion to approve setting the District's annual employer contribution rate to the Texas County and District Retirement System (TCDRS) for Plan Year 2020 at 13.84% (13.50% for Retirement Plan Rate, and 0.34% for Group Term Life Rate). Mr. Covington seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

There being no further business to discuss, Mr. Arrington made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Fuselier seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0. The meeting adjourned at 10:23 a.m.
