Mr. LaPray called the meeting of the Board of Directors of the Orange County Drainage District to order at 2:00 p.m. Mr. Barrow led the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Fuselier made a motion to table consideration of the replat of Craft Lane. Mr. Arrington seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

CONSIDERATION AND AUTHORIZATION FOR DRAINAGE DISTRICT STAFF TO APPROVE THE DRAINAGE PLAN FOR ARIZONA BEND ADDITION, TO BE LOCATED AT THE END OF N. ARIZONA AND E. ARIZONA IN BRIDGE CITY, TX, PREPARED BY JEREMY J. MITCHELL, P.E., DATED JUNE 2, 2020 WITH SUPPLEMENTAL SHEET 3 OF 17 DATED SEPTEMBER 2, 2020, AND THE RELATED PRELIMINARY PLAT PREPARED BY JEREMY J. MITCHELL, DATED JUNE 2, 2020 Mr. Fuselier made a motion to authorize the Drainage District Staff to approve the Drainage Plan for Arizona Bend Addition, to be located at the end of N. Arizona and E. Arizona in Bridge City, TX, prepared by Jeremy J. Mitchell, P.E., dated June 2, 2020 with supplemental sheet 3 of 17 dated September 2, 2020, and the related Preliminary Plat prepared by Jeremy J. Mitchell, dated June 2, 2020. Mr. Arrington seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

CONSIDERATION AND RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ORANGE COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SOUTHEAST TEXAS COOPERATIVE PURCHASING ORGANIZATION ADMINISTERED BY REGION 5 EDUCATION SERVICE CENTER, AND AUTHORIZING DON CARONA AND JOE ESCOBEDO TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS PERTAINING TO SUCH PARTICIPATION

Mr. Fuselier made a motion to authorize the Orange County Drainage District to participate in the Southeast Texas Cooperative Purchasing Organization administered by Region 5 Education Service Center at a cost of \$600 annually, and authorizing Don Carona and Joe Escobedo to execute any and all required documents pertaining to such participation. Mr. Arrington seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

CONSIDER FOR APPROVAL THE AMENDED NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION FOR THE ORANGE COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A DIRECTOR OF DRAINAGE DISTRICT PRECINCT 2 AND A DIRECTOR OF DRAINAGE DISTRICT PRECINCT 3, TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 03, 2020 IN ACCORDANCE WITH CHAPTER 49 OF THE TEXAS WATER CODE, THE TEXAS ELECTION CODE, AND ALL OTHER APPLICABLE LAW AND AUTHORIZATION OF THE OFFICE MANAGER TO SIGN SAID ORDER, BY PERMISSION, FOR EACH DIRECTOR

Mr. Fuselier made a motion to approve the amended Notice of General Election for the Orange County Drainage District for the purpose of electing a Director of Drainage District Precinct 3, to be held on November 03, 2020 in accordance with Chapter 49 of the Texas Water Code, the Texas Election Code, and all other applicable law and authorization of the Office Manager to sign said Order, by permission, for each Director. Mr. Arrington seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF ADOPTION OF QUALIFIED REPLACEMENT BENEFIT ARRANGEMENT WITH TEXAS COUNTY AND DISTRICT RETIREMENT SYSTEM (TCDRS)

Mr. Fuselier made a motion to approve the adoption of Qualified Replacement Benefit Arrangement with Texas County and District Retirement System (TCDRS). Mr. Arrington seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.

CONSIDERATION AND ADOPTION OF THE ORANGE COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT DRAINAGE CRITERIA MANUAL AND REGULATIONS

Mr. Fuselier made a motion to table consideration of the adoption of the Orange County Drainage District Drainage Criteria Manual and Regulations. Mr. Arrington seconded the motion. Motion carried 4-0.
