Following a report by the Evaluation Committee previously designated by the Board, Mr. Ancelot made a motion to select the firm with the highest score and ranking that timely submitted proposals pursuant to the District's Request for Proposals for Grant Application and Administrative Services (RFP-2021-04-TDEM-HMGP-GRANT-LAURA), namely Traylor and Associates, and to authorize the District's General Manager, upon consultation and approval of the District's attorney, to negotiate and execute a contract with such firm on behalf of the Drainage District. Mr. Covington seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
