# EVALUATION AND RANKING OF PROPOSALS SUBMITTED IN RESPONSE TO THE REQUEST FOR COMPETITIVE SEALED PROPOSALS (RFCSP NO. 2021-05-ROOF) FOR THE MAINTENANCE SHOP ROOF REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Following a report by the Evaluation Committee previously designated by the Board, Mr. Scales made a motion to accept and adopt the recommendation of the Evaluation Committee, and to rank the proposals submitted in response to the Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP No. 2021-05-ROOF) for the Maintenance Shop Roof Replacement Project in the following order:

- 1. Argio Roofing & Construction, LLC
- 2. Basco Construction, Inc.
- 3. Mason Construction, LLC
- 4. Advantage USA Inc.
- 5. Jay-B & Group Services

Mr. Covington seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

### **CONSIDERATION AND AUTHORIZATION OF THE GENERAL MANAGER TO:**

A. NEGOTIATE A CONTRACT WITH THE HIGHEST RANKED FIRM THAT SUBMITTED A PROPOSAL IN RESPONSE TO THE REQUEST FOR COMPETITIVE SEALED PROPOSALS (RFCSP NO. 2021-05-ROOF) FOR THE MAINTENANCE SHOP ROOF REPLACEMENT PROJECT, AND TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT ON BEHALF OF THE DISTRICT WITH SAID FIRM, SUBJECT TO THE REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF SAID CONTRACT BY THE DISTRICT'S ATTORNEY; AND

B. IF SAID NEGOTIATION IS NOT SUCCESSFUL, TO NEGOTIATE AND CONTRACT WITH THE NEXT HIGHEST RANKED FIRM, SUBJECT TO THE REVIEW AND APPROVAL OF THE CONTRACT BY THE DISTRICT'S ATTORNEY; AND

C. TO CONTINUE SUCH PROCESS UNTIL SUCH A CONTRACT IS OBTAINED AND EXECUTED OR ALL PROPOSALS ARE REJECTED.

Mr. Covington made a motion to authorize the General Manager to negotiate a contract with Argio Roofing & Construction, LLC, the highest ranked firm that submitted a proposal in response to the Request for Competitive Sealed Proposals (RFCSP No. 2021-05-ROOF) for the Maintenance Shop Roof Replacement Project, and to execute a contract on behalf of the District with said firm, subject to the review and approval of said contract by the District's attorney; and if said negotiation is not successful, to negotiate and contract with the next highest ranked firm, subject to the review and approval of the contract by the District's attorney; and to continue such process until such a contract is obtained and executed or all proposals are rejected. Mr. Ancelot seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

## CONSIDERATION AND APPROVAL OF AN AMENDMENT TO THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021 FOR THE PURPOSE OF BUDGETING ADDITIONAL EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE PURCHASE OF AN AIRBOAT

Mr. Peveto made a motion to approve an amendment to the Budget for Fiscal Year 2020-2021 for the purpose of budgeting additional expenses associated with the purchase of an airboat. Mr. Ancelot seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

CONSIDERATION AND AUTHORIZATION FOR DRAINAGE DISTRICT STAFF TO APPROVE THE DRAINAGE REPORT FOR THE STRUTT STORAGE PROJECT, TO BE LOCATED AT 10967 HWY 12, ORANGE, TEXAS, PREPARED BY SAM FOUNTAIN, P.E., DATED FEBRUARY 21, 2021

Mr. Peveto made a motion to authorize the Drainage District Staff to approve the Drainage Report for the Strutt Storage Project, to be located at 10967 Hwy 12, Orange, Texas, prepared by Sam Fountain, P.E., dated February 21, 2021. Mr. Scales seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
