NOTICE OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
ORANGE COUNTY DRAINAGE DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Board of Directors of the Orange County Drainage District will meet in a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, the 21st day of September, 2021, at 2:30 p.m. at the Administration Building, 8081 Old Highway 90, Orange, Texas. This regular meeting of the Board of Directors was previously scheduled for Tuesday, September 14, 2021 at 10:00 a.m., but was cancelled and rescheduled due to Tropical Storm Nicholas.

A quorum of the Board of Directors is expected to be present for this meeting of the Board of Directors at the location set forth above. However, pursuant to Section 551.127 of the Texas Government Code, one or more Board members or District employees may attend this meeting remotely by means of a video-conference call. Each portion of the video-conference call, except for a matter to be heard or discussed in a properly called executive session, shall be visible and audible to the public at the location of the meeting set forth above.

Members of the public attending the meeting may address the Board regarding an item on the agenda. Persons addressing the Board regarding an item on the agenda, or regarding any other matter, shall be allowed three (3) minutes, or such other amount of time allowed by the Presiding Member of the Board, either before or during the Board's consideration of the agenda item. Members of the public who utilize a translator to address the Board shall be allowed six (6) minutes to address the Board.

7. Consideration and authorization for Drainage District Staff to approve the Drainage Report for the Quiktrip project, to be located near the intersection of I-10 and Highway 62 on the north side of I-10 and the west side of Hwy 62 in Orange, Texas, prepared by Joshua J. Valenta, P.E., dated August 26, 2021.
8. Consideration and authorization for Drainage District Staff to approve the Drainage Report for the Highway 12 Gas Station project, to be located at 1400 Highway 12, Vidor, Texas, prepared by Salim Nizih Obeid, P.E., dated April 9, 2021 and supplemental sheet C4.2 Drainage Calculations dated June 9, 2021.

Consideration and designation of an evaluation committee, consisting of the District Purchaser, General Manager, Assistant General Manager and the Assistant Manager of Special Projects to review, score, and rank all of the submittals timely received in response to the District's Request for Proposals for Grant Application and Administrative Services, RFP-2021-07-FEMA-BRIC, which committee will provide such evaluations to the Board of Directors for consideration, in the Board's sole discretion, in selecting the service provider(s) to be retained to provide such services, considering all of the criteria set forth in said requests for qualifications and proposals.

After the meeting is open in public session, and pursuant to the Texas Government Code, the Board may go into executive session to discuss personnel-related matters (as set forth in Subsection 551.074), property matters (as set forth in Subsection 551.072), and consult with its attorney concerning legal matters (as set forth in Subsection 551.071).
