**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT** the regular public meeting of the Board of Directors of the Orange County Drainage District will be held on Tuesday, March 8, 2022, at 10:00 a.m. at the offices of the Orange County Drainage District, located at 8081 Old. Highway 90, Orange, Orange County, Texas 77630.

During this regular Public Meeting, the Board of Directors will discuss, *inter alia*, the following item:

1. Public Outreach Meeting regarding the Orange County Drainage District's Sabine River Relief Ditch Extension and Expansion Project (Texas Water Development Board Project No. 40019). The project will include hydrologic and hydraulic modeling of the Sabine River Relief Ditch, and the Cow Bayou, Adams Bayou, and Little Cypress Bayou watersheds in conjunction with the development of preliminary engineering, project design, and feasibility assessments for the Sabine River Relief Ditch Extension and Expansion Project. The purpose of this meeting is to review and share with the public generally, and with stakeholders that may be interested in the affected area, an overview and scope of the Project.

The public is invited to attend this meeting. A quorum of the Board of Directors is expected to be present for this meeting at the location set forth above. However, pursuant to Section 551.127 of the Texas Government Code, one or more Board Members or District employees may attend this meeting remotely by means of a video conference call. Each portion of the video conference call, except for a matter to be heard or discussed in a properly called executive session, shall be visible and audible to the public at the location of the meeting set forth above.
