Mr. Peveto called the meeting of the Board of Directors of the Orange County Drainage District to order at 10:00 a.m. Mr. LaPray led the Invocation and the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF JANUARY 2023 BILLS

After review and discussion, Mr. LaPray made a motion to approve the bills for January 2023. Mr. Ancelot seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING THE DISTRICT'S PROPOSED ADOPTION OF UNIFORM TAX ABATEMENT POLICY AND GUIDELINES

The Public hearing was called to order in the usual course of business, where Neal Ford and Douglas E. Manning presented information pertaining to the renewal of the Orange County Drainage District's Uniform Tax Abatement Policy. No one from the public was in attendance. Mr. Scales made a motion to close the public hearing, and Mr. Covington seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

CONSIDERATION AND ACTION TO EXECUTE A SUPPLEMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH THE TEXAS WATER CONSERVATION ASSOCIATION RISK MANAGEMENT FUND TO PROVIDE WORKER'S COMPENSATION INSURANCE COVERAGE TO DIRECTORS WHILE ACTING WITHIN THE COURSE AND SCOPE OF THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES

Mr. Scales made a motion to execute a supplement to the Interlocal Agreement with the Texas Water Conservation Association Risk Management Fund to provide Worker's Compensation insurance coverage to Directors while acting within the course and scope of their official duties. Mr. Covington seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

CONSIDERATION AND AMENDMENT OF THE DISTRICT'S PURCHASING POLICY AND PROCUREMENT MANUAL

Mr. LaPray made a motion to consider an Amendment of the District's Purchasing Policy and Procurement Manuel. Mr. Ancelot seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

Mr. Covington made a motion to amend the District's Financial Policy and Procedures. Mr. Ancelot seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

CONSIDER FOR APPROVAL A RESOLUTION APPOINTING DOUGLAS MANNING AS A MEMBER OF THE INVESTMENT COMMITTEE

Mr. Covington made a motion to approve a resolution appointing Douglas Manning as a member of the Investment Committee. Mr. LaPray seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

CONSIDER FOR APPROVAL A RESOLUTION ADDING DOUGLAS MANNING AS AN AUTHORIZED SIGNATORY TO THE TEXPOOL ACCOUNT

Mr. LaPray made a motion to approve a resolution adding Douglas Manning as an authorized signatory to the TexPool account. Mr. Ancelot seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

CONSIDER FOR APPROVAL A RESOLUTION TO CHANGE THE AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVES FOR THE DISTRICT'S UBS ACCOUNT FROM DON CARONA TO DOUGLAS MANNING

Mr. LaPray made a motion to approve a resolution to change the authorized representatives for the District's UBS account from Don Carona to Douglas Manning. Mr. Covington seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

CONSIDER FOR APPROVAL ADDING DOUGLAS MANNING AS A MEMBER OF THE HAZARD MITIGATION COMMITTEE IN THE PLACE OF DON CARONA

Mr. Covington made a motion to approve adding Douglas Manning as a member of the Hazard Mitigation Committee in the place of Don Carona. Mr. Ancelot seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.

CONSIDERATION AND ACTION TO DESIGNATE NEAL FORD AS ADA COMPLIANCE COORDINATOR, AND DOUGLAS MANNING AS CO-COMPLIANCE COORDINATOR PURSUANT TO SECTION 35.107 OF THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

Mr. LaPray made a motion to designate Neal Ford as ADA Compliance Coordinator, and Douglas Manning as Co-Compliance Coordinator pursuant to Section 35.107 of the Americans with Disabilities Act. Mr. Covington seconded the motion. Motion carried 5-0.
