NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Board of Directors of the Orange County Drainage District will meet in a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, the 12th day of November, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. at the Administration Building, 8081 Old Highway 90, Orange, Texas.

A quorum of the Board of Directors is expected to be present for this meeting of the Board of Directors at the location set forth above. However, pursuant to Section 551.127 of the Texas Government Code, one or more Board members or District employees may attend this meeting remotely by means of a video-conference call. Each portion of the video-conference call, except for a matter to be heard or discussed in a properly called executive session, shall be visible and audible to the public at the location of the meeting set forth above.

Members of the public attending the meeting may address the Board regarding an item on the agenda. Persons addressing the Board regarding an item on the agenda, or regarding any other matter, shall be allowed three (3) minutes, or such other amount of time allowed by the Presiding Member of the Board, either before or during the Board's consideration of the agenda item. Members of the public who utilize a translator to address the Board shall be allowed six (6) minutes to address the Board.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Recognize acceptance of TexPool October 2024 report.
2. Approval of October 2024 bills.
3. Consideration and acceptance of the Certification of Current and Delinquent Tax Rolls by the Orange County Tax Assessor-Collector.
4. Consider for approval renewal of annual membership with Southeast Texas Regional Planning Commission.
5. Consideration and approval of setting the District's annual employer contribution rate to the Texas County and District Retirement System (TCDRS) at 13.74% (13.50% for Retirement Plan Rate, and 0.24% for Group Term Life Rate), or alternatively at such other percentage determined by the Board of Directors.
6. Discussion and approval of Application for Pipeline or Utility Permit submitted by Centerpoint Energy for a gas line to be located at 1006 Alabama St, Orange, Texas.
7. Consideration and enactment of a resolution casting votes for the 2025 election of Directors to the Board of Directors of the Orange County Appraisal District.
8. Consideration and approval of the Second Amendment to the Interlocal Agreement between the Gulf Coast Protection District, the Orange County Drainage District and Orange County, and authorization for the District's General Manager to execute

such amendment, subject to the review and further approval of District Management and the District's Attorney.
